Treasurer report – The treasurer has reminded those who did heat sheets for championships that those moneys have not been turned in.

Old business – We did a recap of the meets from the past year.

A, AA - Recommendation from the executive committee is that the divisions stay the same. John Harnden has agreed to be meet director for the South division.

Zone – Meet went well in Bowling Green. There were some concerns over officiating, and they have been addressed at the zone meeting.

National – National meet went well. M E Lyons won men and combined.
Plymouth Michigan won women.

Competitive Swim Seminar – Held April 30, 2004 in Columbus, Ohio. 80 attendees. Aimed at Executive directors, Aquatic Directors, Program Directors, coaches, etc. We felt that the program was a success and it may be held again. We would like more support from our league if held again.

New Business

Long course – Meet information is posted on the web. Tom has the workers list ready and will post it after the meeting. He has had difficulty with workers not reporting at all or not reporting on time. The executive committee recommends: If a worker position is not filled at the meet, the offending YMCA will be fined \$100 per position. The dollars collected will be given to the team who fills that position. There will be no charge for any changes made before the meet. Recommendation by Toby Boedeker. Second by Bill Whatley. Unanimous approval.

September Meeting – We would like to hold the meeting September 21 at the Resource Center. Mike will check to see if this is possible.

Senior Meet – There are meets in January that will take care of the age group that we addressed with the Senior Meet. The league will not host a senior meet this year.

A & AA – Bill Whatley and his committee are working on a new order of events. They will also look at qualifying times.

AA – March 11, 12, 13

Zone – The order of events is the same as last year. The zone committee has proposed times subject to approval. The meet will be held at C T Branin natatorium March 18, 19, 20, 2005 hosted by Blue Ash and Powel Crosley Francis Parrish has resigned as zone representative and Bill Whatley has been appointed as our new representative.

Nationals – April 5-8, 2005. Fort Lauderdale. National is planning to allow the group representative to make the deck pass for their group and the pass could be used for zones and nationals.

We see no reason that it could not be used for our local meets also. The idea for local meets is that no coach will receive heat sheets without a deck pass. Recommendation from the executive committee Deck Passes are free if credentials are received prior to November 15. Certifications received from December 1 to February 1 are \$25. Any certifications after February for the winter season cost \$100. There will be no charge if the certifications are for a late hire or if the pass is an update because certifications expired. Motion by Aaron Dorfman second by Randy Reynolds. Unanimous approval.

Some changes for the coming year.

All meet information will carry the following statements:

Deck Changes - There will be no deck changes – Penalty will be ejection from the meet.

Relay swimmers - All relay swimmers must be entered in the meet with entries. Penalty -\$5 per relay swimmer that must be entered at the meet.

Constitution - Our constitution has not been revised for over 20 years. We would like a committee to review the constitution and revise it. Volunteers – Bill Whatley, Dave Murray, Mike Leonard, Claudia Multer.
